The HCSIA will award two \$500 scholarships.

Criteria

- Applicant must have had a sheep project and shown at the Hardin County Fair.
- Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited college for the 2023 - 2024 school year.
- Applicant and parent/guardian must be residents of Hardin County or a Hardin County School District prior to entering college.
- Applicant must be maintaining a 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.

Method of Application

- Application forms will be made available from the high school guidance counselor or by contacting the O.S.U. Extension office at 419-674-2297.
- ***Applications must be delivered by February 24, 2023 to the Extension Office 1021 W. Lima St. Suite 103, Kenton 43326.***
- Official transcript of high school or college grades must be submitted with application.
- Applicant must include 2 letters of recommendation with application.

Selection Process

- Committee will consist of two Board Members
- Committee reserves the right to interview all applicants, if needed, after reviewing all applications.
- Scholarship recipients will be announced at the Lamb Banquet.

Method of Distribution

- Scholarship awards will be paid in one lump sum.
