

Goat Exhibitors,

We are officially one week away from the Hardin County Fair. Here are a few important reminders:

- 1. DUNF – Drug Use Notification Forms must be completed by Saturday, September 2. Fill out this form once for EACH MARKET ANIMAL: <http://go.osu.edu/dunf>**
- 2. All exhibitors (breeding and market) must have Scrapie tags on file for ALL goats on the fairgrounds.** You submitted your Scrapie premise ID and tag numbers with your fair entries, HOWEVER, many of these numbers are incomplete. **Please check your scrapie tag numbers and make any corrections on the google sheet at <http://go.osu.edu/hardingoattags>.** Again, please include the premise ID *and* Scrapie Tag number.
- 3. All market animals will complete a destination form at the scales on Monday.** This form tells the sale committee if you will be taking your market animal home or if it will be going to the packer. Please be prepared in advance to fill out this form.

- 4:00 – Market Boer Goat Show – large show arena

Wednesday

- 1:00 - Commerical meat showmanship, commercial breed show, wether dam classes, Born and Raised market goat show (small animal arena)

Saturday

- Jr. Fair Livestock Sale

Sunday

- 7:00 p.m. – animals going home released
- 9:00 p.m. – animals sold in sale released
