- Applicant must be maintaining a 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.

Application Requirements:

- Complete attached application form
- Submit an essay pertaining to "What the horse industry means to me." *How has being involved in the equine industry changed your life?*
- Applications forms will be available by contacting the O.S.U. Extension office at 419-674-2297
- Applications must be delivered by February 1, 2023, to the OSU Extension Office 1021 West Lima St. Suite 103 Kenton 43326.
- Applicant must include 2 letters of recommendation with application.

Selection will be based upon:

- Academic performance
- Participation in school/community activities
- Leadership ability
- Ability to work independently

Selection Process:

• Committee will consist of a 2-3 person judging panel

- Applicants maybe called in for an interview, if needed, after all applications are reviewed
- Scholarship will be awarded at horse banquet or other appropriate venue.
- Applicants are strongly encouraged to attend banquet.

Method of Distribution:

Scholarship will be paid in one lump sum to student to be used as student needs. Submitting your application form confirms you agree to method of distribution.
