- Entry videos must be 3-5 minutes long.
- Editing videos and adding graphics and/or background music is NOT permitted.
- Entered demonstrations will be judged according to the attached rubric.
- OSU Extension Hardin County reserves the right to publish all submissions on their website, social media, and/or YouTube Channel.
- Demonstrations can be on any topic appropriate to a 4-H audience and do NOT need to be related to your 4-H project.

ENTERING THE CONTEST

- Members who wish to enter the contest will create a demonstration video in .mp4 format that is 3-8 minutes long.
