

### ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

Achievement awards are given to 4-H members who have excelled in a specific project or development area. These are the TOP youth in the County. Winners at the county level are sent on to the state level judging.

Winning an Ohio Achievement Award means that you are the top 4-Her in the State for your project area. State achievement award winners get an all-expenses paid trip to Atlanta, GA to serve as a delegate to National 4-H Congress. Congress delegates participate in workshops, community service, cultural trips, and the National 4-H Gala and Dance.

## SHOOTING SPORTS CAMP

July 9-14, 2024 Canter's Cave 4-H Camp

Shooting Sports Camp is a 6-day camp at Canter's Cave 4-H Camp in Jackson, Ohio. Campers select a shooting discipline to master during the camp: archery, rifle, pistol, shotgun, living history, or hunting and wildlife.

The camp is run by Nationally certified 4-H Shooting Sports volunteers who focus on safety and youth development.

Hardin County 4-H will award two \$500 scholarships to seniors graduating high school in 2023.

#### Applicants must:

- Be graduating in 2023
- Be active 4-H members for 2022 and 2023

The Achievement Record serves as the application for the scholarship. Any senior who turns in the achivement record will automatically be considered for the scholarship.

The applications will be judged by a panel of 4-H Professionals from other counties. Winners will be notified in May and recognized at the 4-H Awards Banquet in the fall.
